Spoke to Betty and **she thinks she is doing good**. She will be going in for a **CTC next week and find out what her markers are** and in two weeks she will have a **Pet & CAT scan**. She asked about eating sugar because she likes to have a little bit of pie or sweet once in a while. We agreed **it would be best to restrict her sugar intake** but a small amount would be ok if her

doctors have not restricted her. She said they haven't but she was **reading about how Cancer loves sugar and wanted to be safe.**

6-06-2011

Talked to Mr. Wetzel to see how Betty is doing. He said he will have her call me back. Betty did call back and said she is feeling really good and is still taking the Poly. Betty said her thermogram came out very good and she is now seeing an integrative medicine Doctor that says she has no sign of cancer.

5-29-2013

Spoke to Betty and **she has started using fermented soy**. However, she says that it gives her diarrhea. She said she is just laying low to see if it works for her. She takes a bottle a day of the fermented soy.

1-28-2016

Talked to Betty and she is doing well except she does have a sore on her breast. She is doing 2 tsps a day of Poly and will increase her daily dosing. She said that Neosporin has helped stop the bleeding and that she is going to increase her Poly up to 8 tsp a day and continue on CoQ10 and D3.

1-25-2017

Spoke to Betty about her interest and concerns about stem cells and ozone. She had tried ozone and felt uncomfortable but will do the stem cells and is doing IV Vitamin C. She still has bleeding although the Neosporin and honey she learned about has helped. **She will increase** her Poly to 8 tsp from 2. We had a great talk about her family.

2-07-2018

Betty had the RGCC test and it shows she **should take Poly to continue to target her ongoing cancer recovery**. She has been diagnosed with congestive heart failure and said she will take 8 tsp a day plus CoQ10.
