My brother has **faithfully taken the Poly-MVA** since my last report. His **M Spike Protein continued to drop while on the Poly-MVA** and **finally reached 0** on 01-07-08 and **has remained at that level since that time**. He no longer requires chemotherapy and is doing very well.
