11-09-09 - 5-05-11 - 7-26-11 2-26-13 - 6-02-16 - 12-11-18 - 3-13-20

During the time I used Poly-MVA, I had 24 radiation treatments following surgery for uterine cancer. Since the end of the treatments I have had 2 follow-up medical exams, 3 and 6 months after the treatment were completed. Besides 2 internal pelvic exams, I had a CT scan of my abdomen and chest. No evidence of growths or metastases were found.

As I continue to feel better and get over the effects of the surgery and radiation treatments, I have been **told by my radiologist and gynecological oncologist that I am healing very well.** My general health seems improved, although symptoms of health issues I had before, especially irritable bowel syndrome and chronic fatigue persist. **My experience had been very good with the Poly MVA program**.

I used **2 teaspoons 3 times daily** and I am **still using Poly as a maintenance today.** I started off as a Quality of Life participant and kept a record of my experience and filled out reports. **Poly-MVA contributed and supported me thru my cancer.**

I used radiation along with other vitamins and minerals plus AHCC. The difference Poly-MVA made is incredible:

Carol called to report 2 years of good news about her health. No sign of cancer. Continues to take Poly-MVA but will start to taper down her dosage to reach a maintenance dosage.

2-26-2013

6-02-2016

Carol called inregards to Husband, Joe. **He has just been diagnosed with Bladder cancer 1A grade 3**. The tumor now covers 1/4 of his bladder but has not invaded the muscle. Tests revealed it was an aggressive form of Bladder cancer so Joe had surgery to remove the tumor which was sent to pathology. The recommended treatment suggested by his Doctors is **BCG** which is the most common intravesical immunotherapy for treating early-stage **bladder cancer**.

12-11-2018

Spoke to Carol. **She said that both her and Joe are doing well.** They had a cold during Thanksgiving but are much better now. **They continue to remain in remission** and are diligent about taking daily maintenance doses of Poly.

3-13-2020

Talked to Carol who said she is currently battling the flu. She is still using Poly MVA for maintenance. Just opened her last bottle and may need more in a month. She said her husband now takes it occasionally with her but he is still doing fine.
